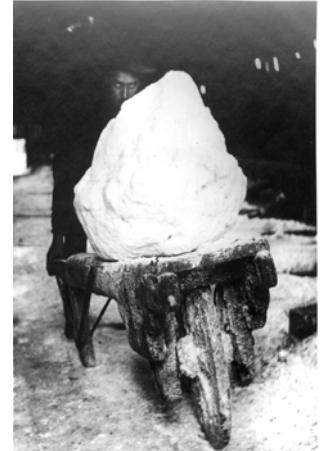
Historical Tram Tour - Limited to 45

Take a trip back in time on a Historical Tram Tour. Groups will be entertained while learning about the physical and geographical characteristics of Onondaga Lake, the Iroquois Confederacy, the Willow basket industry, the Mudlock and the importance of the canals, the Turn of the Century amusement parks that dotted the shoreline, and the discovery of salt and the development of the salt industry. Before or after the tram ride, learn about the history of salt production in Syracuse inside the Salt Museum which will be open for free self-guided tours. There will be someone available to answer questions.

Sainte Marie Among the Iroquois is a re-creation of the French Mission that once stood on the shores of Onondaga Lake from 1656-1658. Browse the museum and learn about the 17th century culture of the Haudenosaunee (Iroquois), the French and their meeting here. Visit the Interpretive Center and converse with the costumed interpreters about daily life in the 1650's. Demonstrations in carpentry, blacksmithing, cooking and other unique activities are available.
